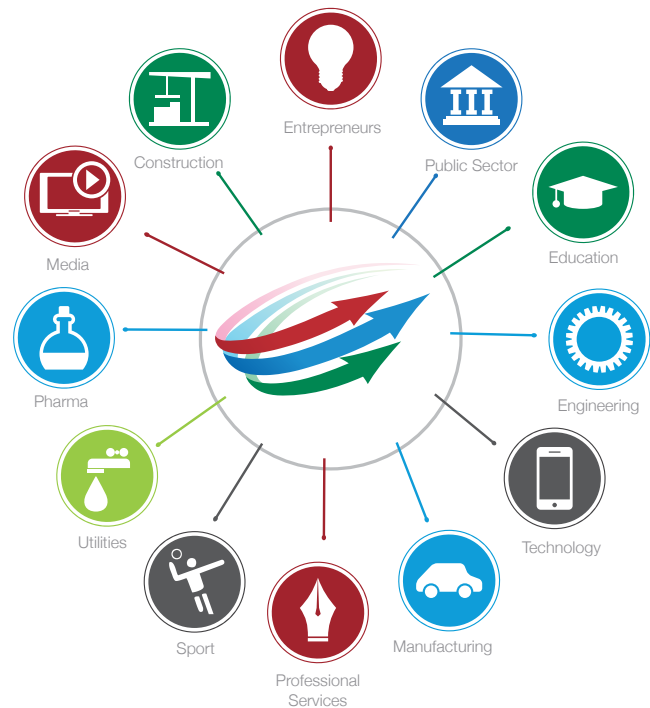

The Advanced Leadership Programme is a modular learning experience: so you don't have to juggle your work and life commitments while you invest in your leadership.

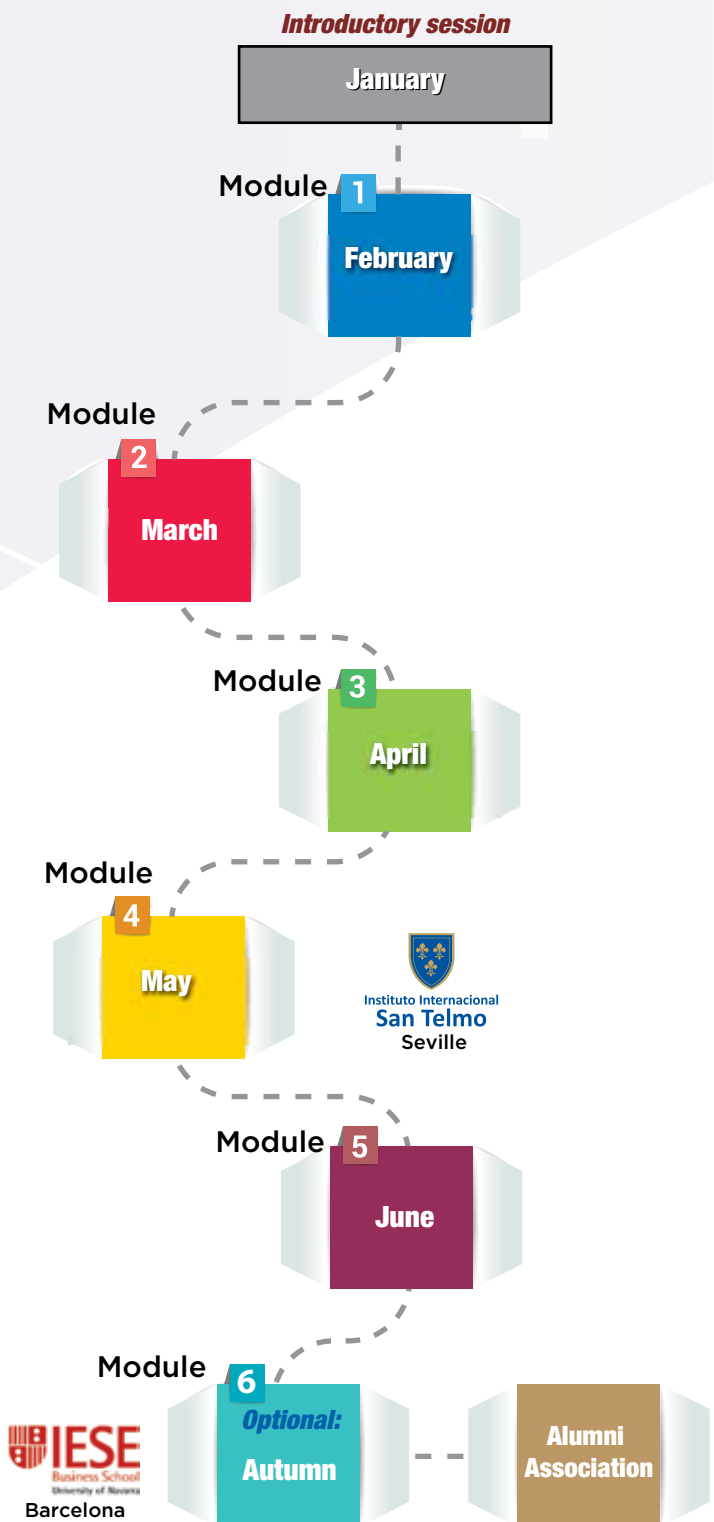
When you're back at work, between modules, you'll be able to deploy what you've learned.

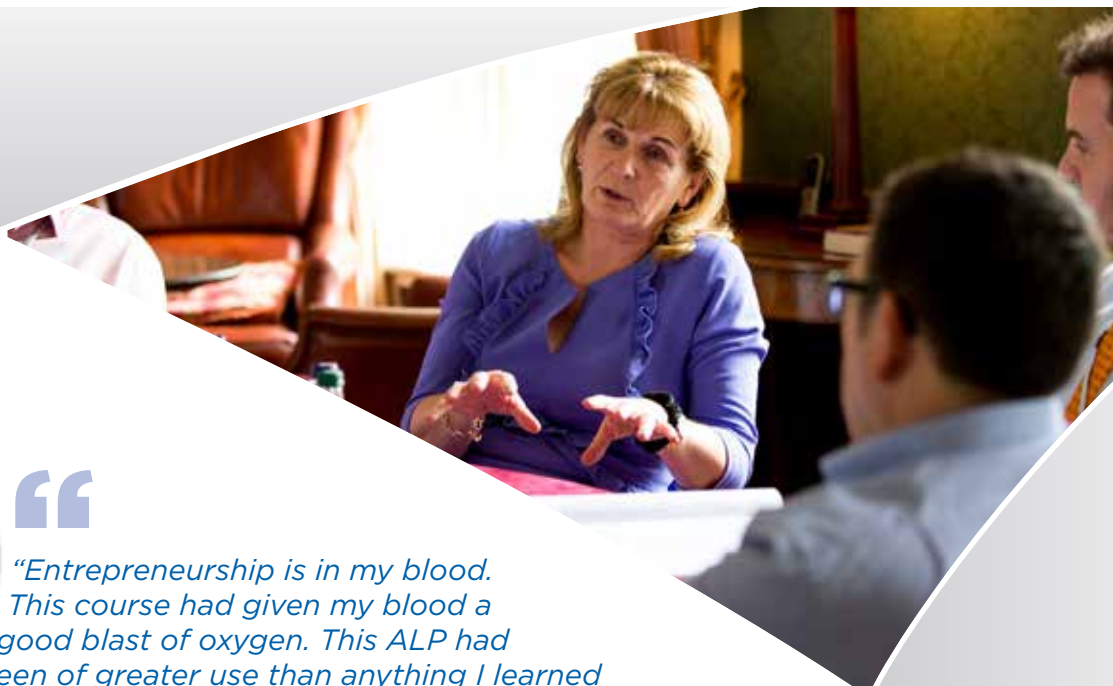

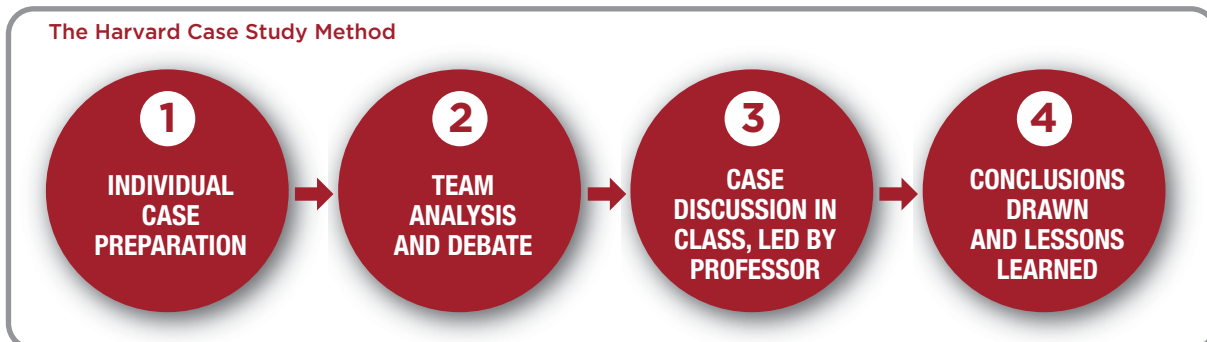
An innovative approach to leadership development


